***Food Logistics* Announces Its 2010 Top 85 3PLs**

Leading Business Magazine Presents Annual Listing of Third-Party Logistics Providers

Melville, NY — August 16, 2010 — *Food Logistics*, the only publication exclusively dedicated to covering the movement of product through the food supply chain, this week announced the fifth-annual listing of the *Top 85 3PLs* in its July/August 2010 issue.

In 2006, *Food Logistics* announced its first “50” list of third-party logistics providers that were helping food companies optimize their warehousing and transportation operations. Last year, the magazine expanded the list to 70 companies. This year, the magazine added 15 new 3PLs to the list, for a total of 85 companies.
